## Does the Bible teach how I may gain salvation?

- Q. What is sin?
- A. It is the transgression of God's Law.
- 1 John 3:4
- Q. Who has transgressed God's Law?
- A. We are all transgressors in God's eyes.
- Romans 3:23; Psalm 51:5; 1 John 1:8
- Q. What is the punishment for sin?
- A. Eternal death
- Romans 6:23; Revelation 20:15

- Q. What must I do that my sins can be forgiven?
- A. We must first acknowledge our sins and confess them to God.
- 1 John 1:8,10; 1 John 1:9; Psalm 32:5; Psalm 51:2-3
- Q. I have confessed my sins to God. What next?
- A. If we believe in our hearts that Christ is our Saviour and died to grant us forgiveness and eternal life, then we must be **Baptised** as He was baptised.

- Q. I have been baptised. What next?
