

WHO IS THE SHE?

Q. How are we called to study Scripture?

A.We are to compare spiritual things with spiritual things.

Line upon line, precept upon precept.

1 Corinthians 2:10-14; Isaiah 28:9-10

Q. What does a woman represent in Bible Prophecy?

A. A woman in Prophecy represents the **professed** people of

God; she can be **faithful or unfaithful**.

Jeremiah 6:2; Isaiah 51:16; Revelation 12:1

Q. How many women do we see in the Book Revelation?

A. We see two women.

Revelation 12:1; Revelation 17:1-3

Q. Who does the woman of Revelation 12 represent?

A. She represents the faithful & obedient believers of God, His Bride.

Jeremiah 3:14,<mark>20; Isaiah 54:5; Isaiah 62:5; Ezekiel 16:8;</mark>

Ephesians 5:25-27,32

O. What is she clothed in?

A. She is clothed in light; further described as clean, spotless garments.

Revelation 12:1,19:7-8; Ephesians 5:25-27

WHO IS THE SHE?

Q. Who does the woman of Revelation 17 represent?

A. She represents the unfaithful Church, rife with apostasy and false teachings.

Ezekiel 16:15,16,20,30,32; Jeremiah 3:1,8,9; Hosea 3:1; Revelation 17:5

Q.What is she clothed in?

A. She is arrayed in colourful garments, gold and precious stones, showcasing her immense wealth. Notice that she is not arrayed in pure white garments, like the woman of Revelation 12.

Revelation 17:4

Q. What is in the hand of this harlot woman?

A. A golden cup full of her apostate teachings and practices.

It was also filled with the blood of God's faithful believers.

Revelation 17:4; 6

Q. What is she riding?

A. She is riding a beast.

Revelation 17:3

Q. What does a beast represent in Prophecy?

A. A Kingdom or World Power.

Daniel 7:17,23; Daniel 8:20-21

Q.What do the 10 horns on the beast represent?

A. They represent '10' kings. Not literal, but symbolic, for 10 in Scripture is tied to something in its totality.

Revelation 17:12-13

Uses of 10 in Scripture:

10 Commandments- The Law of God

10 Virgins- The Church

10 Plagues- God's complete wrath

10 Kings- All the kingdoms of the earth

10 Lepers- All of sinful man

Q.What will the 10 kings eventually do unto the Harlot?

A. They shall eventually turn against her and take away their support from her shortly before Christ comes.

WHO IS THE SHE?

We see a **Harlot** woman, that is, a church, professing to be the true followers of Christ, yet are apostate in nature, full of idolatry and abominations. She leads the entire world into her deceptions and commits spiritual adultery with the various leaders of the world. She, this apostate church, sits upon a beast, that is, she rules upon an earthly kingdom. She is an apostate church which also rules as a state power. She unites in a world wide confederacy to persecute and martyr God's faithful people at the end of the time, **the Bride of Christ**.
