Throughout the Scriptures, we always find that before God pours out His judgments upon the wicked, He always sends a message of warning, that the wicked may turn from their wicked ways and be saved.

Whether it be Noah preaching to those living before the Flood, Lot warning the inhabitants of Sodom & Gomorrah, Moses admonishing Pharaoh before the Exodus or Jeremiah warning the children of Judah before their fall to Babylon, God is the same yesterday, today and forever more; He never changes.

For that reason, we shall search the Scriptures to find this message of warning, that the inhabitants of the world may have an opportunity to hear the Word of the Lord, as He speaks to each and everyone of us in these last days, warning us of the judgment to come.

Notice the below examples found in Scripture, where God uses His faithful servants, to sound the alarm of warning to the wicked, that they may have the opportunity to turn from their wicked deeds and be saved:

NOAH- Genesis 6:5-8,11-13; 7:1,21-23; 2 Peter 2:5; Matthew 24:37-39

LOT- Genesis 19:4-5, 12-14, 23-25; 2 Peter 2:6-8; Jude 1:7; Luke 17:28-29

MOSES- Exodus 2:23-25; Exodus 3:7-10,19-20; Exodus 5:1-2; Exodus 10:27-28; Hebrews 11:24-29

JEREMIAH- 2 Kings 17:3; Jeremiah 7:1-7,23-26; Jeremiah 18:11;
Jeremiah 4:6-7; Jeremiah 25:8-9,11; Jeremiah 52:4-7, 12-15;
Lamentations 1:1-4

Q. Why in each case did God give so many warnings and rebukes to the wicked before bringing judgments upon them?

A. God is merciful towards us, He loves us and takes no pleasure in our destruction.

Micah 7:18; Lamentations 3:22-23; John 3:16-17; Ezekiel 33:11

Q. What does God say to His faithful children as it relates to warning the wicked?

A. We are called to be watchmen, making known the truths of God's Word & His standards plain & showing the people that by their wicked practices, they are sinning against God.

Isaiah 58:1; Ezekiel 33:1-9

Q. What does Scripture teach us about the character of God?

A. They are many attributes to the character of God, His mercies, forgiveness, love, etc, but in this case we refer here to His unchangeable nature. Because of His unchangeable nature, we can trust His Word. Heaven and earth shall pass away, but His Word endureth forever.

Malachi 3:6; Hebrews 13:8; James 1:17; Numbers 23:19

Note: If God does not change, this means, that as He had faithful watchmen who spoke messages of warning to the wicked before sending His judgments in past times, in the same way, He will have faithful watchmen upon the earth in these last days of earth's history, who shall give a warning to the wicked inhabitants of this world, for the gospel has now gone throughout the entire world.

Q. What will be the distinguishing marks of those faithful servants of God, living in these last days before the return of Christ?

A. They will be commandment keepers, possessing the testimony of Jesus, which is the gift of prophetic understanding and they shall have the faith of Jesus Christ.

Q. What are angels referred to in the Bible?

A. Ministering Spirits. They bring messages from God and relay them to man that man may act upon them.

Hebrews 1:13-14; Revelation 1:1

It should be noted that throughout Scripture, it is not the angels that have been tasked with preaching the Gospel, but rather, God uses man because it is man that has fallen because of sin. It is the Church that is the light of the world. The angels are there to reveal God's will to man and to bring various messages from the courts of Heaven, but it is not their responsibility to preach the Gospel of Christ. They are simply ministering spirits as Paul says, sent to minister unto those of us, who shall be the heirs of salvation in Christ Jesus.

Q. What is God's final message to this last generation?

A. The message of the 3 angels found in the Book of Revelation. It is a message of warning, given out of love, because God takes no pleasure in our destruction, instead, He wants us all to be saved.

Revelation 14:6-12; Revelation 18:1-4

This final message is given by God to His faithful people living upon the earth in these last days, that they may be faithful watchmen, proclaiming the present truth for this time and warning the world of the imminent 2nd Coming of Christ and His judgments that shall be poured out upon all the unrepentant.

The proclamation of these messages are to be given to all the world; "every nation, kindred, tongue & people." It is a world-wide message. As God has said in His Word on countless occasions, this earth shall pass away, the wicked shall be destroyed and sin and sinners along with the father of sin, shall be no more. Therefore God gives this warning to all the earth that we may all have the oppourtinity to repent and turn to Christ, that we might be saved.

Q. What do the three angel's messages tell us in summary?

A. We are told that it is a global message that must go to all people, it is the Everlasting Gospel that has been given from the beginning of time.

It points us back to the Creator and to the memorial of His creative works, which is the Sabbath of the 4th Commandment. It tells us that Babylon, *that Apostate form of Christianity in the world today*, has fallen morally, never to rise again.

It tells us that all those who should bow in obedience to Babylon, and her false religious laws, therefore receiving the *mark of the beast*, shall receive the outpouring of God's unmixed wrath & lose the opportunity to receive eternal life in Christ.

It further tells us that if we continue to do wickedly by remaining in Babylon, then we shall continue partaking of her sins and shall be destroyed. Therefore this message calls all who shall heed it to come out of Babylon, for it is a message of separation.

Satan is constantly seeking to cast a shadow about these messages, so that the people of God shall not clearly discern their import, their time and place; but they live and are to exert their power upon our religious experience while time shall last."
